

5-storeyed structure razed in PCMC

Pimpri Chinchwad Municipal Corporation (PCMC) demolished a five-storey unauthorised structure at Ganeshnagar, Bopkhel on Tuesday as part of a demolition drive held under Ward-D.

Executive engineers RV Kudhekar and deputy engineers Sanjay Ghube, Vilas Jagtap and Hanumant Shinde were present at the site.

"The drive took place under the police security of Vishrantwadi. Nearly 30 police personnel were deployed at the site. The illegal structure was demolished with help of advance pochain and the demolition will continue on Wednesday," said PCMC engineering department spokesperson Shirish Poredi.

The illegal construction belonged to Gopichand Rathod.

PCMC had filed 413 FIRs against those who had constructed unauthorised structures in their jurisdiction. Out of these, 153 unauthorised structures on 6,79,718 sq ft area have been demolished till Tuesday.

PCMC commissioner Shrikar Pardeshi reiterated that 2,159 unauthorised constructions that came up after March, 2012 will be razed at any cost. puneinbox@dnaindia.net
